Distinguished Fiji Award Recipients

The Archons established the Distinguished Fiji Award in 1965. Their policy states, *"The Distinguished Fiji Award will be presented annually to no more than six graduate brothers who shall be deserving of recognition for their faithful and unselfish service to Phi Gamma Delta or their special contribution to mankind and society at large."*

To publicize the award, the Archons determined to distribute it to 111 charter members, consisting of living past Archons, former Section Chiefs with two years or more of service, former Field Secretaries, past Ekklesia host committee chairmen, and past appointed officers. This practice continued through 1968. At that point, it was felt that continuing the practice diminished the importance of the six annual recipients. Since then the award has only been given to six living brothers annually, with the exception of a seventh, posthumous award to Cecil J. "Scoop" Wilkinson in 2001.
