Graduate Initiate Guidelines

Phi Gamma Delta stands to benefit greatly from recruiting quality men who have already graduated from college, yet had never previously joined a fraternity. Ideal prospects include staff and faculty members on each chapter's respective college campus and fathers of undergraduate brothers.

Graduates are not initiated into the Fraternity because they have achieved some prominence or to bestow a special honor. The graduate must have a close relationship with the Chapter and fully intend to serve Phi Gamma Delta on a long-term basis.

Guidelines

- To be eligible to join Phi Gamma Delta, a prospect must have never been a member of another NIC fraternity.
- If not presently enrolled in college, the prospect needs to have graduated, at a minimum, from a four-year college.
- The chapter must conduct votes for pledging and Initiation (reference Article IV, Section 1 and Sections 3 or 5 of the Constitution), and the chapter must Initiate him by the Rituals of the Fraternity.
- The Graduate Initiation Form must be completed (available at <https://www.phigam.org/file/GraduateInitiationForm.pdf>) and Initiation fee (currently \$200) + \$15 shipping/handling must be paid to the International Fraternity.
