PHI GAMMA DELTA'S NEW MEMBER EDUCATION MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

The minimum requirements for new member education can be found in Section 19.34 of the Fraternity's Bylaws. Below is an outlined summary of the requirements outlined in the Bylaws.

All chapter new member education programs must:

- **Be written** and available for review by the Chapter's graduates, Field Secretary and Greek Advisor upon request.
- **Be organized and planned in advance.** A detailed week by week schedule should be included within the program.
- **Be a maximum of 12 weeks in length.** The Fraternity recommends program length of 6-8 weeks. Chapters must abide by campus requirements where they are more stringent.
- Use and provide to each new member the **Purple Pilgrim.**
- Focus on education, not training. This means that all testing and similar requirements focus on general fraternity knowledge, not useless memorization.
- New members shall be initiated following the conclusion of the new member education program.
- Abide by Section 25.28 **Prohibition of Hazing.**
