Expectations for Undergraduate Brothers of the [Chapter] Amidst the COVID-19 Pandemic

This resource is intended to provide house corporations, chapter officers and chapter advisors (PLs and BCA members) as a starting point for setting expectations with undergraduate brothers who are returning to campus, and/or living in a chapter house facility. These expectations should be adapted to be consistent with all local and university guidance and policies and communicated to all members of the chapter and those living in the chapter house.

House corporations are strongly encouraged to adopt expectations of brothers living in / utilizing the chapter house. Each chapter and colony is encouraged to set expectations for its members returning to campus and is encouraged to model their expectations off of the below suggestions and [CDC Congregated Housing Guidance](#).

In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, and in an effort to keep our members and communities safe, the [CHAPTER /HC NAME] has set the following expectations for all brothers and new members in the chapter to promote the safest, cleanest, and most comfortable living environment possible for all brothers living in the chapter house.

- All members must adhere to CDC, college / university and local guidance pertaining to the novel coronavirus. This includes, but is not limited to, guidance related to wearing of masks / facial coverings, social distancing and practicing proper hygiene.

- Members living in the chapter house, or anyone visiting the chapter house (if permitted) must follow all COVID-19 related rules and regulations implemented by local governance, the College / University, and the House Corporation.

- It is encouraged that the chapter house be closed to non-members. The Chapter should limit the number of non-residents visiting the chapter house.
- All brothers and guests (if permitted) are expected to maintain social distancing protocols, particularly when utilizing common areas.
- Facial coverings are required in all common areas including hallways and bathrooms, and when entering / exiting the chapter house facility.
- The chapter house must be regularly cleaned and disinfected, following protocols set by the university and/or house corporation. All brothers must follow house cleaning duties/requirements as assigned by the House Manager or House Corporation.
 - o This includes but is not limited to enclosed spaces such as stairwells, laundry facilities, dining areas, bathrooms and other common/high touch areas.

- Signs clearly displaying social distancing, face covering and building entering guidelines and requirements should be posted in entrances, common areas and bathrooms.
- Any gatherings or meetings of the Chapter must comply with local guidelines (ex: not more than X people as directed by local officials, use of facial coverings, etc.).
- Parties and other social gatherings are not permitted in the chapter house. Brothers are expected to comply with all guidelines related to gatherings and social functions regardless of location.
- Any brother who is feeling ill, and/or exhibits symptoms of COVID-19 should contact [list established college / university contact, or local health authority contact] to be tested and quarantine based on the procedures set forth by the House Corporation and/or the College / University. Those who test positive must inform [BCA MEMBER NAME] immediately.
 - o This brother will need to comply with self-isolation guidelines, limit exposure to staff/brothers and limit their use of shared spaces, such as bathrooms and dining areas.
- All brothers are expected to comply with local health officials and their instructions regarding potential exposure to COVID-19.
- If outside visitors are permitted by the House Corporation, all brothers are responsible to not allow/invite guests who have experienced symptoms of COVID-19 or have tested positive and not received a negative test result since.
- Every brother living in the facility should maintain a clean personal/room space, following all cleaning guidelines and expectations put forth.
 - o This includes taking out your trashcan and disposing of garbage in the proper place, removing any clutter, regularly cleaning/disinfecting high contact areas.
- Brothers who do not comply with these expectations will be held accountable by chapter leadership and may be subject to disciplinary action by the chapter and/or College / University.
- Brothers who do not comply with these expectations may have their lease terminated and/or lose access to the chapter house.
- All brothers are responsible for following federal and local guidance outside of the Chapter house facility as well.
- Brothers living in the chapter house will need to bring their own CDC/EPA approved cleaning supplies for their personal spaces.
